



Position Opening - Campus Prefect

Jesuit High School has an immediate opening for Campus Prefect.

Primary responsibility

- Supervise students in and out of classrooms during Jesuit's return of students to campus for hybrid instruction.
- Prefects will be on campus from 7:30 am - 3:00 pm, with 30 minutes for lunch.
- Prefects will be responsible for communicating with faculty members teaching remotely, in a hybrid on-campus environment (*ie*, 12-16 students in each classroom).
- Prefects will manage the classroom environment for 80 minutes per period, for 3 or 4 periods per day.
- Additional responsibilities include supervising students on campus, including during lunch and at the end of the school day.
- Additional stipends may be available for supervising students after 3:00 pm.
- Potential coaching opportunities may also be available.

Compensation: Daily wage of \$160 per day, four days/week.

Requirements:

- Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university,
- Successful background check, fingerprinting, and CARE child-protection program.
- Comfort working in a technology-integrated school environment and ability to keep students focused on instruction being delivered remotely.
- No specific teaching experience is required

As with all positions, Jesuit seeks candidates who care deeply about students, support the school's Jesuit and Catholic identity, and demonstrate cultural competency and a commitment to fostering an inclusive community.
