Working at Bellarmine College Preparatory requires a commitment to the mission and values of the school, as well as an enthusiasm for contributing to its co-curricular programs.

Responsibilities:

- Teach Freshman and upper division Computer Science courses (Computer Science Principles, Programming in Python) in the Computer Science Department
- Comfortable teaching in multiple computer science areas as needed (eg AP Computer Science, Computer Programming)
- Collaborate with colleagues on aligning computer science curriculum, instruction, and assessments
- Hold regular office hours and meet with students who need assistance
- Communicate regularly with parents, counselors, and administrators to ensure the success of each student
- Demonstrate a commitment to ongoing professional growth
- Fulfill periodic substitution and prefecting responsibilities
- Abide by all school policies and regulations
- Complete other duties and/or projects as assigned

Minimum Qualifications/Skills:

- BS in Computer Science, Computer Engineering or other STEM related field
- Demonstrate an understanding of the latest pedagogies for teaching Computer Science
- Programming experience with Python or similar structured programming language
- Integrate and use technology for instruction and assessment
- Design authentic assessments and analyze results to adjust instruction
- Ability to work effectively with staff and students at all levels, displaying a positive attitude, demonstrating cultural proficiency, and exhibiting motivation and drive; this includes the ability to provide clear expectations to students while building positive relationships
- Excellent verbal and written communication skills, including the ability to express oneself clearly and concisely, and successfully interact with external and internal constituents; this includes the ability to resolve conflicts
- Self-directed with proven ability to assume responsibility, work independently, creatively solve problems, and move work/projects to completion with minimal supervision
- Ability to prioritize and complete tasks/assignments/projects within established time frames and with

- strong attention to detail, including the ability to stay focused and manage multiple projects/activities simultaneously
- Proficiency with Microsoft Office Applications and the ability to operate all other applicable software

Preferred Qualifications/Skills:

- MS Degree in Subject Matter or in Teaching
- Experience teaching computer science classes at middle school, high school or college level
- Familiarity with new domains for technology: machine learning, data science, mobile app development, drone programming and/or robotics
- Familiarity with Jesuit secondary education
- Programming experience in Javascript, Java, and/or C/C++

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to lift 10 pounds, using proper lifting techniques
- Ability to sit, stand, and/or move around the classroom as needed
- Ability to travel around our campus safely and comfortably
- Ability to use a keyboard (or an alternative input device) and other office equipment
- Ability to read information in printed material and on a computer screen (often for extended periods of time) and/or on a mobile device/laptop

General Information:

- This position pays according to our established faculty salary scale, available here
- This position is classified as Regular Full-Time Exempt; employees in exempt positions are expected to work as many hours as their job responsibilities require, which may include evenings and weekends
- This position is eligible for Bellarmine's excellent benefits package
- The general expectation is that this position will begin work on/about August 5th to prepare for the school year and is to be completed in accordance with the published school calendar or as instructed by the school's administration
